

## REVISED APPENDIX SIX- FREQUENCY OF LITTER POLLUTION SURVEYS

The **Litter Pollution Survey** is undertaken annually, usually between the months of March and December, by each local authority. Once the minimum requirement has been met, the authorities may conduct additional surveys at their own discretion, as often as they require. Each survey, which takes approximately 10 minutes to complete (excluding travel time), involves assessing 50m stretch of roadway or footpath. The minimum number of surveys required of any local authority was 20 and is now 32, whereas the maximum was 350 and is now 560. The results of the survey will be logged on a standardised form, and the national results analysed and reported upon by the Litter Monitoring Body.
